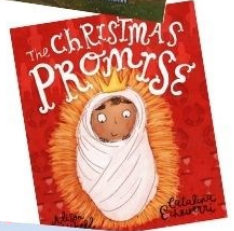
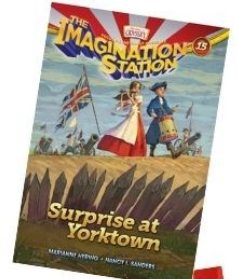

# FREE HEARING, VISION AND DENTAL PUBLIC CLINIC SCHEDULE

Hearing, vision and dental screenings are **required by state law** for all children entering kindergarten at public and private schools. Our team provides these **free screenings** for all Berrien County residents **by appointment only**. We cannot accept appointments after Aug. 28. If you do not complete your child's screening by Aug. 28, you will need to arrange and pay for a private appointment with hearing, vision and dental professionals.
