# **TUITION INFORMATION FOR 2025-2026**

## Unsubsidized\* Tuition

## \$10,000 per student

\*total annual expenses, divided by the number of students attending, subsidized by fundraising and donations.

## Grace Christian Discounts:

## Multi-child Discount:

⇒ Two students per household: 5%; Three students per household: 10%; Four or more students: 15%; Every student after 4th is free.

Full Time Pastoral Discount: (Not eligible for multi-child discount except 5th child free)

- $\Rightarrow$  Gross Family Income: \$80,000 a yr. or more: 25%
- $\Rightarrow$  Gross Family income: \$79,999 or less: 50%

#### **Referral Discount**:

⇒ \$500 to every current family that refers a new family (maximum of two families per year). If a family referred does not stay active in our school past the first quarter, discount will be deleted. Paid out by semester: \$250 each semester.

## Grace Christian Scholarships:

<u>Gladis Lewis:</u> This scholarship is offered to African-American students, living in Benton Harbor, MI, who wish to enroll in Grace Christian School, and qualify for financial aid. This scholarship is renewable, but recipients must maintain a "C" average while in this program.

<u>Thrift Store Scholarship</u>: A family may apply if their gross annual income is less than \$80,000. This scholarship requires volunteering at our thrift store for 6 hours a month per qualifying student. Amount earned is equivalent to \$200 per student per month.

#### Mission Students:

If you need more help we can put your students on a list (We do not use names. ex. Family 1, Family 2) where supporters of GCS are invited to help you close the gap between what you can pay and what we need to operate the school. To qualify for this list your gross annual income of less than 125% of the poverty line. We require tax returns for any income based financial awards. Your data is only seen in the business office where your personal identity is scrubbed when evaluations are made.
