Dear Students and Parents,

It looks like we made it through January, but still have some winter weather ahead of us. While we are hopeful for smoother winter weather to come, there is still the possibility of snow days as winter continues. As always, student safety is our top priority. We realize our population covers many counties and not every circumstance is the same. If school is scheduled but you do not feel safe traveling from where you live, we encourage you to remain at home.

One of the benefits of our hybrid learning model is that students are able to continue their work from home without falling behind. With several snow days already behind us, our facilitators have adjusted coursework to keep everyone on track with a reasonable workload and still finish by the end of the school year. Moving forward, it will become increasingly difficult to do this in a way that allows students to do their best work, especially for students who are unable or choose not to work from home on snow days.

For this reason, **all future snow days will be designated as e-learning days for secondary students.** This approach allows us to keep learning moving forward, as well as continue to prioritize safety.

Participation on a snow day remains a family decision, as students do technically work at their own pace. However, students do have end-of-year goals, and choosing not to complete work on e-learning days may make those goals more difficult to reach. For accountability, any missed work will need to be completed upon return, similar to work missed during a regular absence.

Middle School:

Middle school students are able to complete most (if not all) of their work from home, even if workbooks are left at school. With the exception of tests and quizzes:

- Math and literature work can be completed from home
- Science, history, and grammar videos, readings, and writing assignments are accessible online

If workbooks are left at school, students should focus on learning the material, so they are prepared to complete workbook questions and move forward upon returning.

High School:

High school students should complete their assigned lessons in Ignitia, excluding assessments. Please email Mrs. Corwin as needed to unblock assignments. Lessons following assessments can be unblocked so students may continue working in each subject.

Please don't hesitate to reach out to any of us if you have questions or need clarification. Thank you for partnering with us to keep students safe, supported, and learning as we navigate the remainder of winter.
